# **Building Priorities Update and General Time Line**

In an effort to keep everyone updated as to what remains to be done before we set up modules, listed below is a **general**, (as of today), outline of what still needs to be done, and their approximate order:

- Install the heating and air conditioning (in progress)
- Install Plumbing
- Install Electrical
- Install the bathroom shower, fixtures and Tile floor
- Install water heater and sloop sink
- Secure the building with jimmy proof deadbolts and re-key all locks
- Drywall, tape and float all framed areas
- Paint drywall, doors and molding.
- Install mailbox.
- Build out work bench area
- Install ceiling fans in at least the layout area

I'm **sure** I have forgotten some things, and I'm **sure** the priorities will change as we go along, but you can see we have a lot of work to do over the next few weeks to get ready for our modules.

# Additional Items to be Completed After Module Set Up

To give you some insight as to "where we go from here" the following is a list (in no particular order) of interior and exterior items that will be completed as funds allow: **Interior** 

- Finishing of the kitchen area.
  - Ceiling fans meeting room
  - Floor covering in the kitchen.
  - Member storage lockers
  - Drop ceiling in the hall, bathroom, kitchen, and office areas.
  - Installation of the paint booth.

#### Exterior

- Finish our parking lot & driveway.
- Begin doing some simple landscaping and tidying up of the property (no real \$ investment but some sweat equity).
- Install front gate.
- Fence around air conditioning units
- Build a well house.

As usual I'm sure this "wish list" will be revised many times, but at least this outlines some of the things we will be looking at doing as time and money allows.
