# **Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad Employee Appreciation Special (EAS)**

Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad announced it would again sponsor an Employee Appreciation Special (EAS) train ride for its employees and their families. The 2001 EAS will have the Frisco 1522 as motive power for the train, which consists of 13 BNSF passenger cars and 3 St. Louis Steam Train Association (SLSTA) support cars. Train rides will not be provided for the general public, but only for BNSF employees and families. There should be many opportunities to see the engine and train along its travel route. The EAS will operate approximately 3,900 miles and will have ride events in the states of Oklahoma and Texas.
