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Routine Building Maintenance!

Just a reminder starting immediately, instead of checking off an item as you clean it we are asking you initial the item in the week box in which it was done (please see the new form on the bulletin board). The first person on the monthly list is the team leader responsible for seeing the work gets done. If a crewmember can't work that month it is their responsibility to trade with someone else, otherwise they are expected to pull their share of the load. We also agreed that instead of creating a separate outside maintenance schedule we would just increase the crew to 6 & expand the months work to include routine outside maintenance, such as mowing, trimming, and weed control. We will be starting the expanded schedule this month! Each month's crew will need to decide if and when they will schedule the outside maintenance!

<u>About two weeks before a crew's</u> <u>month the team leader should call all</u> <u>team members and discuss the plan for</u> your shift!

In addition to scheduled maintenance the crew is asked to:

- Let the president know of any items that need repair or replacement.
- Supply one bag of 30 gallon or better trash bags whether we need them at that time or not (because we will in time).
- Buy any needed cleaning items such as toilet bowl cleaner, paper towels, etc.
- Supply the month's needs of gas for both the lawn mower and weed whackers.
- Replace the two (2) furnace filters with fresh ones.

If there is any questions about the above please let me know, otherwise we all are expected to do our share, or in the case of physical limitations, what we can do. It should go without saying if you cannot do some chores because of physical limitations you are **not** expected to do so.

Based on the expanded crews and a membership of 24 we should all be on a crew about every four months, barring any switches you make with someone else. The next two months schedules are as follows:
