<u>Directions to Steve Hashagen's for APN's</u> <u>Christmas Party</u>

Take I 45 to HWY 242 west (Needham road exit), toward community college

Take 242 west to Greenbridge Drive (2.8 miles), Turn left onto Greenbridge Drive.

Take Greenbridge Drive to Research Forest Drive... 1 mile (Greenbridge drive ends in a "Y" at Research Forest)

At Research Forest Drive take a left onto Research Forest

Stay on Research Forest Drive to the first stop light (4/10th mile), which is Cochran's Crossing

At Cochran's Crossing take a right turn onto Cochran's Crossing for about 100 Yards.... The entrance to my subdivision is the first right hand turn once you are on Cochran's Crossing.... it's called Cochran's Green.

At Cochran's Green take a right off Cochran's Crossing and then take an immediate left (about 50 feet from subdivision entrance) that street is Cochran's Green Circle.

Once on Cochran's Green Circle go up three blocks and Petal Cup will be the third street on the left...# 2 is the first house on the right hand side.
