One way would be to donate some time at the upcoming shows to help man the booth and talk to the people who stop by out booth to visit. Another would be to be sure the hobby shops have our flyers available to anyone looking for a club in the area. Other places are work, church, etc. remember our goal is two new members a year and with the loss of four we have some ground to make up. Everyone should set a goal of getting one new

member during the next year.

There should be no reason we can't achieve that goal. We are the only club that even begins to offer what we offer at \$20.00 a month!
